2013 Season Review

National League

The youth based National Women's League had a new format, instead of a Northern & Southern section every federation played each other once. The top three qualified for the finals, with second playing third to determine who would play the first played team in the final.

Paul Grieg took the Capital side to second place in the league with four wins, including 3-0 over Auckland, 7-2 over Waikato-Bay of Plenty and 6-0 over Southern, two draws and just one loss (2-1 to Northern). This set up a semi final with Mainland where unfortunately Capital went down 2-0.

Waterside Karori's Emma Rolston led the way with eight goals in eight games and won the leagues golden boot.

Central League

Massey University won their second Central League title in a row. They started the season with an emphatic 17-0 obliteration of Upper Hutt City. A game where Emma Boyack scored seven and Rhonda Bridges six goals. It was Boyack and Bridges that dominated the scoring for the rest of the season, Boyack finishing with 23 goals in the league and Bridges with 22. Massey's first loss came in the second to last game of the season, 4-3 to title challengers Waterside Karori. It wasn't enough to knock Massey of the top spot though. They also had a cup run which took them to the final of the National Woman's Knockout Cup (NWKOC) where they went down 2-0 to Three Kings United of Auckland. They also were the first Palmerston North team since 1974 to win the Kelly Cup.

Despite beating Massey in the second to last game, **Waterside Karori** finished runners up three points behind, a shock early 2-1 loss to Valeron Wanderers and a loss against Massey ultimately costing the talented Waterside Karori which included NZ U20s Emma Rolston and Briar Palmer. Rolston led the goal scoring getting 18 goals in the season.

Seatoun who had added Gary Jenkins to their coaching team as a co-coach alongside Kirk McPherson finished comfortably in third, eight points behind Waterside Karori and five points ahead of Wellington United. They started with two losses but then a 7-1 victory over Upper Hutt City set them up for the rest of the season where they only dropped 10 points in the next 11 games. Annie Olsen scored 16 in the league and cup, while Maxine Cooper got 10 in the league. They got to the quarter finals of the NWKOC and were runners up in the Kelly Cup.

Wellington United had a terrible start to the season winning only one of their first eight games but they turned it around and won five in a row which saw them finish comfortably in fourth place.

Valeron Wanderers signed Michaela Boxall from Palmerston North End and she finished their top scorer with seven goals in the league. They managed four wins, including a 9-1 thrashing of Upper Hutt City, but this was tempered by a 10-2 thrashing from city rivals and eventual league champions Massey University.

Lower Hutt City struggled with goalscoring getting only 19 all season, while at the other end they had similar problems leaking 46 goals, including six times conceding more than four in a game.

Newly promoted **Upper Hutt City**, who included Football Fern Wendi Henderson in their squad struggled. Champions Massey University gave them a baptism of fire beating them 17-0 in the first game. By the time they got their first win, six games into the season they had conceded 45 goals. They did manage four wins which was enough to keep them in the Central League for another season.

Adam Walker took on the coaching role at **Marist** after Brian Blellock went to BNU. The change in coach seemed to work at first with two wins and two draws in their first five games. Alas that was as good as it got and with them picking up just one point in the rest of the season they found themselves relegated to the Capital Premier division for 2014.

Women's Premier

The 2012 Capital Premier League runners up, **Stop Out** went one better this season. They started with a 1-0 loss to BNU, but after that setback they didn't lose a game and eight times managed to beat the opposition by four or more goals and conceding only one goal in their last nine games. Melanie MacDougall with 15 and Laura Doyle with 14 were the top scorers. Winning the league gave Stop Out the chance of Central League if they could beat Central Region champions Wanganui Athletic. They didn't manage this going down 2-0 in Wanganui and 3-2 at home to lose 5-2 on aggregate.

Relegated from Central League last season, **Brooklyn Northern United**, with new coaches in John Laing & Brian Blellock started with six wins and a draw in their first seven games saw them at the top of the league. A 1-0 loss to Stop Out saw them drop into second place and despite only one more loss in the season that's where they stayed. Fiona Pou top scoring with 15.

Victoria University scored for fun with Jess Fraser getting 18. Six times they managed to score five or more goals, topped off by a 14-0 demolition of North Wellington. Losses to Stop Out and BNU saw them finish in third place

Wellington United Reserves (Sapphires) may have used 33 players and struggled for consistency, but they still managed eight wins and finished comfortably in fourth place. Emma Gibbin top scoring with 13.

Marist Reserves had a new coach in Rochelle "Oskar" Searancke. Starting with three straight losses they struggled and either won or lost, only managing two wins in a row at the end of the season, they finished in fifth place eight points behind Wellington United and eight points ahead of Waterside Karori.

Matt Reweti's **Waterside Karori Reserves** team started the season with a 4-1 win over North Wellington, but from this point on they struggled with only two more wins and failing to score on six occasions. Vanessa Olsen's seven goals helping get the team into sixth place.

Lower Hutt City Reserves only managed six goals all season and they came in a run of four games which included their only wins, against North Wellington (1-0 & 4-0). Outside of that they failed to score on 11 occasions, including seven in a row, but amazingly managed to finish seventh.

North Wellington managed the same number of goals as Lower Hutt City in six but they were unable to manage a win, only getting a point in their last game against University, The draw against University may have been seen as a victory after they had suffered a first round 14-0 pasting! A 12-0 loss to Stop Out and six other games where they conceded more than five goals coupled with eight games they failed to score in saw them relegated.

Women's Knockout Cups

There were 12 entries from the Capital & Central region into the National Women's Knockout Cup. Seatoun were the team that made it the furthest beating Lower Hutt City 2-0 in the quarter final before going down 4-0 to Coastal Spirit of Christchurch in the Semi-Final.

There were 16 entries into the Kelly Cup. Central League Champions Massey University became only the second Palmerston North team to win the Kelly Cup when they beat Seatoun 4-1. The previous winner from the Manawatu was Palmerston North Saints in 1974, the second season the cup was played for.

Brooklyn Northern United won the Premier Cup beating Wellington United Sapphires 3-0 on penalties after a 1-1 draw. The Premier plate was won by Victoria University beating Lower Hutt City Reserves 2-0

The lower division Executive Plate was won by Marist beating Wellington United 3-0 in the final

2013 MATCH REPORT - FINAL Mainland Pride scored their first ASB National Women's League title in the competition's twelve-season history on North Harbour Stadium's outer oval on 8 December, coming from behind to down two-time defending title-holders Northern Football 4-2 in the final women's football game of 2013. The visitors, who earned their spot in the final by downing Capital Football 2-0 in Wellington a week ago, took time to find their feet initially, this being just the second game they've played on natural grass in their W-League campaign. Needless to say, Northern were nowhere near as hesitant, and crowned their stronger start by deservedly taking the lead in the ninth minute. Estelle Harrison floated a delightfully weighted free-kick into the danger zone which Nicole Stratford gleefully headed home unchallenged - 1-0, to the delight of the plentiful numbers of Northern fans in attendance. Mainland gradually began to get their act together, forcing a twelfth minute corner which Laura Merrin whipped into the goalmouth. Aimee Phillips was somehow denied at close quarters by Pam Yates, who, two minutes later, raced out to save at the feet of the charging striker, after Emily Jensen and Lauren Dabner - a terrific game - combined to good effect. Merrin's foul on Tayla O'Brien on the edge of Mainland's penalty area presented Northern with a glorious chance to double their lead in the eighteenth minute. Harrison squandered the initial opportunity by blasting her free-kick into the wall, but was very soon in possession of the ball again, thanks to the rebound. This time, the fullback delivered a low ball into the stride of Katie Rood, who wriggled her way through a couple of challenges in the penalty area, only to come to grief as Geena Gross' timely challenge put paid to her progress. Lily Alfeld smothered the ball to snuff out this threat, and two minutes later plucked Harrison's inswinging corner off the head of Tiffany Paterson, as Northern piled on the pressure in pursuit of a second goal. Jensen took one for the team in the 21st minute, the defender blocking a Chloe Knott drive before slumping to the ground in immense pain after landing awkwardly on her ankle. She was off the park for seven minutes receiving treatment, during which time Northern moved in for the kill. Harrison unleashed a thunderous twenty-yarder which fizzed over the bar in the 25th minute, while Alfeld's wayward clearance soon afterwards presented O'Brien with a pot-shot at an untended net from twenty-five yards out on the angle. Meikayla Moore came to her team-mate's aid with a goal-line clearance on this occasion, while the post was Alfeld's friend in the 28th minute as she dived to her left to keep out a driven curler from Rood. The post denied the striker, who appealed for a corner without success, Alfeld appearing to have tipped the shot onto the upright with her fingertips. With the statuesque figure of Jensen returning to the fray following this raid, Mainland were back at full strength, and within four minutes had turned the game on its head big-time! On the half-hour, Merrin picked out Dabner, who drifted past a couple of opponents before slipping a peach of a slide-rule pass into the stride of Belinda Van Noorden, as she charged through the inside left channel. The tall striker picked her spot beyond Yates - 1-1, game on! Very much so just ninety seconds later, as Mainland took the lead. Northern failed to clear Merrin's corner, and from the resulting melee, Phillips emerged triumphantly - hers was the decisive touch which put her team 2-1 up. This certainly wasn't in Northern's script, and they wasted little time in endeavouring to regain the upper hand. Jensen took another one for the team when blocking a Paterson piledriver ten minutes before half-time, while seconds later, a Harrison free-kick ricocheted goalwards off Rood, only for Alfeld to smother the danger. But they were getting a bit frustrated, as O'Brien's callous trip of Merrin indicated, an offence which referee Anna-Marie Keighley didn't hesitate to punish with the yellow card. Before half-time, the combination which opened the scoring came close to contriving an equaliser. It was a corner from Harrison this time, but the recipient was Stratford, who soared high on the far post but directed her header just past it. Mainland hadn't played as well as they could in the first spell, but come the second forty-five minutes, there was only one team in the contest football-wise, and Northern simply had no answers to the passing game the visitors employed, with Annalie Longo a particularly prominent figure as the half wore on. Just four minutes into the half, the Football Ferns star started going through the gears, linking with Phillips to play Van Noorden in on the right. Her cross for the charging figure of Phillips fell a touch behind her fellow front-runner, but racing up in support was Emma Proctor, who unleashed a furious drive straight at Yates. The 'keeper parried the shot, and regathered it as the midfielder followed her effort in, but Yates was less certain in her touch four minutes later, gifting Mainland a corner after letting a pass-back get the better of her. Merrin's delivery found Jensen soaring above all-comers on the far post, only to head the ball a foot over the bar. Seconds later, a jinking run from Longo saw her combine with Van Noorden to present Proctor with another chance.	This time, Liz Milne got in a vital tackle, her last notable contribution to the match as she was soon to depart on a stretcher. While she made a brief return to the fray, I'm fearful that most dreaded of injuries has struck down another undeserving victim. As Milne lay on the sideline receiving treatment, Mainland exploited their numerical advantage to the fullest by increasing their lead in the 62nd minute. At the heart of the move was Longo, who, six minutes earlier, had sent a twenty yarder sizzling past Yates' left-hand post after working an opening with Van Noorden. This time, Longo linked with Merrin, Proctor and Van Noorden down the left, the last-mentioned working her way into the penalty area before slipping the ball inside to present Phillips with a shooting chance. She duly beat Yates at her near post but hit the upright, the ball ricocheting across the face of goal towards the far post. Racing in to meet it was Longo, and she fair slammed the ball into the back of the net to give Mainland a 3-1 lead which looked unassailable at this stage of the game, so dominant were they at this point. That dominance continued five minutes later, Van Noorden and Dabner combining for Phillips' benefit. Her low shot was cleared to safety by Stratford, three minutes before Dabner took charge of proceedings in midfield and engineered two openings in as many minutes. The first saw Van Noorden dashing through the inside right channel, the striker rounding Dallas Olsen en route to the byline, from where she picked out Phillips at the near post. Her stabbed ten yard effort was parried then gathered by Yates, who dived to her right to deny Longo seconds later, Dabner having evaded a couple of challenges before slipping her fellow midfield marauder through Northern's stretched rearguard. Only a timely tackle from Olsen denied Van Noorden in the 72nd minute, after Merrin had skipped past a couple of opponents before playing in her tall team-mate, after which the local supporters were afforded a bit of encouragement by the sight of a by now rare Northern raid, which culminated in O'Brien picking out the diving figure of Rood with a cross. The striker's header was tipped round the post by Alfeld, who had largely been a spectator throughout the second spell, so impotent had Northern been in the face of Mainland's dominance. But the title-holders weren't beaten yet, and in the 82nd minute dragged themselves back into the match in unlikely fashion. Brittany Coleman, Milne's replacement, lobbed the ball forward in Rood's direction, prompting the striker to execute a looping header. It proved too good for Alfeld, arcing over her and under the bar - 3-2, and a grandstand finish on the cards. For all of two minutes. Northern were piling on the pressure when substitute Briar McNamara was impeded on the left, an incident which referee Keighley deemed not worthy of a free-kick. Northern's supporters in the immediate vicinity went nuts in response, but while they were letting their emotions explode, Longo played to the whistle, latched onto the ball and promptly sent Van Noorden powering away down the right once more. Upon reaching a point some twenty-five yards out on the angle, she let fly, the ball soaring over the stunned figure of Yates, who could only look on in despair as it crashed into the top far corner of the net, restoring Mainland's two-goal advantage. That goal broke Northern's spirit, and a fifth Mainland goal was on the cards three minutes later, as Longo and Merrin worked a short corner. The fullback's cross to the far post found Jensen scoring skywards once more, but her bullet header careered across the face of goal. 4-2 the score remained, and after the bizarre sight of Mainland substitute Maia Vink being denied the chance to take the field in stoppage time - whoever filled out the team-sheet erred where her shirt number was concerned - the final whistle sounded to the delight of the Mainlanders, who celebrated their maiden triumph at this level with undisguised glee. How starkly their joy contrasted with Northern's "fans", the vast majority of whom stormed out of the ground after the final whistle and before the presentations, their lack of dignity in defeat disappointing to see, particularly for those players who had been part of Northern's successful campaigns in the past two seasons, when many of these same "fans" had been only too keen to bask in the reflected glory. The boisterous band of Mainland supporters who made the trip north did their team proud, and delighted in seeing the ASB Women's League trophy being added to the ASB Chatham and ASB National Women's Knockout Cups, which were won by Christchurch clubs in September's finals. At a time when their city is still in recovery mode from the earthquakes which have affected us all in some way, shape or form, the successes of Mainland's football teams in rising above the challenges they've faced to ultimately provide their city and region with something to shout about is well worthy of the applause and acknowledgement of all NZ football folk. 2013 MATCH REPORT - FINAL

Mainland Premier Women's League champions Coastal Spirit became the first Christchurch team since inaugural winners Nomads United to claim the ASB National Women's Knockout Cup on 15 September, edging Glenfield Rovers 1-0 at ASB Park thanks to a last-gasp own goal.

It was very much a case of the local team riding their luck in front of a partisan crowd, for Rovers dominated all the key elements of the game - possession, territory, shots on goal ... Pam Yates barely had a save to make throughout the entire match.

But Spirit had spirit aplenty, and a never-say-die approach which never wavered, even into the fourth minute of stoppage time - a minimum of three had been indicated - when Laura Merrin hoisted a free-kick into the danger zone.

Glenfield captain Rebecca O'Neill attempted to volley it clear, but only succeeded in slicing her effort skywards, the ball steeping into the azure before dropping down deep inside Yates' six-yard box, virtually under the crossbar.

The 'keeper's attempt to catch the sphere proved fruitless, and in the midst of Emma Proctor flying in, and making contact with Yates in the process, the ball crossed the line, to the delight of the Coastal fans.

Referee Anna-Marie Keighley awarded the goal, but then had reason to reconsider her decision when assistant Sarah Walker drew her attention to Proctor's foul. But the contact with Yates had occurred after the ball had crossed the line - goal, with roughly thirty seconds remaining.

Caitlin Campbell chanced her arm from distance straight from the kick-off, but Glenfield's hopes were dashed, and in truth, they only have themselves to blame - the old adage "You takes your chances, you wins your matches" rings true yet again.

Lily Alfeld kept Spirit in it in the first half, in tandem with Merrin. Hers was a massive defensive display - the number of times she won the ball through block tackles would have entered double-digit territory by the final whistle, with a 61st minute double-tackle saving a near certain goalscoring opportunity.

Thanks to these efforts, she was a fully deserving winner of the Maia Jackman Trophy, the much-prized individual honour with which the Cup Final's most valuable player is presented post-match.

Alfeld, with her first half efforts, and newly-named Football Fern Meikayla Moore, who grew another leg as the game went on, were the only other players in white who caught the eye in a final dominated by Glenfield, for whom Caitlin Campbell, in particular, was a driving force.

She it was who instigated Rovers' first opening, after Spirit had enjoyed the better of the exchanges in the first five minutes. Campbell picked out Tiffany Paterson in space on the right, and raced forward to meet the winger's subsequent cross with a volley which deflected off Chloe Jones and arced towards the top right-hand corner of Alfeld's goal.

The goalkeeper leapt up and pawed the ball out, with Moore on hand to complete the clearance. Eight minutes later, the fullback played the ball forward to Chloe Webster, who controlled the ball neatly on her chest before swivelling to send a long-range volley soaring over Glenfield's crossbar.

In between times, persistent work by Merrin on the left thwarted the progress of Paterson, O'Neill and Emma Humphries, and created the pressure which saw Webster catch Bridgette Armstrong in possession and set up Lauren Dabner for an eighteen-yarder being parried then gathered by Yates.

Glenfield responded with a string of chances, led by Katie Rood. She burst down the left and outpaced the ponderously performed Maia Vink before picking out Emily Oosterhof. Her lay-back invited Campbell to let fly, but Alfeld was right behind her twenty-yarder.

On the quarter-hour, a Rood cross wasn't dealt with by the Spirit defence, allowing Paterson to swoop. Alfeld parried her first effort, and got her fingertips to her second attempt. But the ball was heading into the net until Moore got back to clear off the line.

After O'Neill headed a Campbell cross past the far post, Rood picked out Paterson with a peach of a pass which allowed the speedster to whip in a cross. It wasn't cleared adequately, with Campbell being invited to let fly from the edge of the area. The ball was bound for the top corner of the net until Alfeld launched herself high to her right and tipped the shot to safety.

Ten minutes before half-time, a Humphries ball forward prompted an error from Moore which Rood was swift to pounce upon. She surged forward before slipping Oosterhof through with just Alfeld to beat, but her attempted lob was parried by the 'keeper, and another Glenfield chance went begging.

Alfeld again saved from Oosterhof soon after - Paterson supplied this opening, after which Spirit were afforded a rare chance to take the lead when Dabner caught O'Neill in possession. It needed all the nous of Rovers' captain to prevent the midfielder from fully exploiting the opening, with referee Keighley unmoved by Dabner's appeals that she had been fouled in the course of attempting to take advantage of O'Neill's blemish.

The action soon returned to the Coastal Spirit goalmouth, with a Campbell corner to the far post being headed narrowly past the upright by O'Neill three minutes before half-time. An even better opening befell the travelling team five minutes into the second spell.

Oosterhof worked a one-two with Chloe Knott which allowed the winger to whip in a cross. Neither Vink nor Jones dealt with the delivery, and the ball fell invitingly for Paterson, eight yards out and with just Alfeld to beat. But she snatched at her volleyed attempt, and the ball flew wide.

With misses of this nature befalling Glenfield, the feeling was growing that this wasn't meant to be their day, and that Coastal Spirit's name was destined to be added to the trophy, the first Cantabrian team to triumph since Nomads United in the inaugural 1994 final.

Campbell sent another twenty-yarder sizzling over the bar soon after, before Merrin's brilliant double denial on the hour thwarted both Knott and Paterson, after Proctor had gifted possession to the talented Bolton native, who was bidding to win the Cup with her second club in as many seasons.

Spirit were beginning to tire, both physically and mentally, by the time the second half reached its half-way mark, but Moore found another leg to accommodate her toiling team-mates.

Her rampaging run down the right culminated in a cross to the near post which caused confusion between Yates and Humphries, and resulted in a corner. Two corners, in fact, both of which were driven in by Merrin and created plenty of concern for Glenfield, who managed to scramble clear each time.

Rovers' cause wasn't aided by substitute Jess Innes herself being substituted through injury just eight minutes after entering the fray inside the final twenty minutes, during which Glenfield huffed and puffed but failed to blow the house down.

They nearly paid the price for not doing so in the 81st minute, when Moore worked a one-two with Webster before unleashing a shot which narrowly cleared Yates' right-hand angle. Thirteen minutes later, Spirit's luck held out once more, only this time it had a silver lining - the Cup was theirs.
