# 2025 Season Review

## National League Championship

Capital Football again partnered with the top Central League sides to compete in the Women's National League (WNL) for the third year in a row.

**Wellington United**, became the only team to qualify in all three seasons of the Capital Football partnership so far. They did this by winning the Central League for the seventh time in 10 seasons. They were unbeaten, the second time they have achieved this, but this time it was a perfect season with 18 wins from 18 games.

League newcomers, **Wellington Phoenix U18**, finished in second place, but as the Wellington Phoenix have an agreement with NZF that their reserve team plays in the National League, they were unable to qualify, however many of the players did appear for the reserves in the league.

It meant the second team to partner with Capital Football came down to last years National League Finalists, Waterside Karori and perennial challengers, Petone. It was a hard fought race and it was **Petone** who prevailed edging Wharfies by one point.

Results in the first round went against the play book. Diamonds, despite being away to Western Springs, were expected to start with a win, but conceding two goals in the first 10 minutes saw them on the back foot and despite pulling a couple back they went down 4-2. Meanwhile Petone came up against Northern League Champions, West Coast Rangers and despite being up against it for most of the game a late breakaway goal for Wharfies import, Renne Bacon, saw them win 1-0.

Wellington United started slowly with just one win in their first four games, but then won their next five games scoring an incredible 29 goals and conceding just two. The squad that had gone undefeated through the Central League were bolstered by the return of the clubs first Football Fern, Maggie Jenkins. Jenkins had been playing professionally in Turkey and showed that she should still be with a fantastic season, scoring 15 goals and being named the league's Most Valuable Player. Another player that helped boost the Diamond in the National League was club legend Sarah Alder, who had been concentrating on Futsal, she came back into the Diamonds for the National League and made her 200th appearance for the club she has been at since she was 14.

Despite beating both finalists, Eastern Suburbs and eventual Champions Auckland United, the slow start ultimately cost the Diamonds their chance of being in the final and they finished in third place.

Petone's opening 1-0 win over West Coast Rangers could and was described as a shock result and unfortunately the rest of the season proved this. Petone managed only one more win, 3-0 against the hapless Central team (who failed to score a goal in the season) and they didn't manage a goal in their last four games.

### **Kate Sheppard Cup**

There were 13 entries from the Central League region (Capital \ Central) and under the current guidelines that meant that the byes required in the first round were determined by a draw rather than league placings from the previous season.

This meant that newly promoted Miramar Rangers received a bye into the second-round while, 3rd place Petone and 1st place Wellington United drew each other in the first round. That game was played under lights at Newtown Park and resulted in a 3-1 win for the Diamonds. Meanwhile Upper Hutt City hammered North Wellington 9-0.

In the second round, the teams that got byes entered, Wellington Phoenix Reserves smashed Palmerston North Marist 8-1, Miramar Rangers defeated Victoria University 1-0 and Waterside Karori saw Upper Hutt City off with a 5-0 win. Wellington United were drawn to a technically new club in Te Kotahitanga, or TK as they have become known. TK are the tier one club for the Kapiti Coast Region with the clubs on the Kapiti Coast feeding players into them. Drawing Wellington United was the fourth time in five years that either TK or their predecessor, Kapiti Coast United had done so and they must be fed up of that by now, especially considering they have never scored and conceded 21 goals, the latest result being a 5-0 win to the Diamonds!

Round three saw the Diamonds take on the Wellington Phoenix Reserves in another Friday night game under lights at Newtown Park, a crowd of around 500 witnessed a very close game that could have gone either way, the Phoenix managed to win 1-0. Waterside Karori easily defeated Miramar 3-1 to set up a quarter final clash against the Phoenix.

The Phoenix, coached by last seasons Waterside Karori coach, Tori Schiltengen, had a comfortable 4-1 win and then met Cashmere Technical in the Semi Final. A 2-1 win saw them reach the final for the first time. They came up against defending champions Auckland United and lost 4-1.

### **Kelly Cup**

The encroaching of the Futsal season on the Football season and the extension of the Central League to 10 teams made the Kelly Cup very difficult to schedule. Despite a proposal to make the Kelly Cup a tournament for division 1 – 4 teams, Capital Football decided that the cup would be awarded to the team that went the furthest in the Kate Sheppard Cup, Hence Wellington Phoenix Reserves were awarded the Kelly Cup for the 2025 season.

### **Women's Central League**

A controversial late change was made in 2024 when Capital Football decided that the Central League would be increased to 10 teams. The reasoning behind this was to accommodate the Wellington Phoenix's request to enter an U18 team into the league as part of their memorandum of understanding (MOU) with Capital Football.

The decision was presented to clubs as a "fait accompli" with Capital Football claiming they had consulted on this change. Despite this being challenged by several clubs they stuck to the decision to increase the league to 10 teams, despite this technically being against Capital Football's own rules.

With the Wellington Phoenix U18s being added to the league, it was decided that the remaining places would be decided by a playoff between the bottom placed Central League team (Seatoun) and the top eligible Capital (Miramar Rangers) and Central region (Palmerston North United) teams.

This saw Miramar Rangers play Palmerston North United at Weka Park in Raumati, which Rangers won with a last minute free kick from Ella Wilson. Palmerston North United then beat Seatoun 1-0 the next weekend to confirm Miramar Rangers and Palmerston North United as the new teams in the Central League.

For 2024's top teams, new coaches were the order of the day. Wellington United Diamonds, Guillermo Schiltenwolf stepped back from the coaching and concentrated on his Director of Football role. Andre Cantin-Buckley, who had been at Victoria University the season before, returned to Wellington United as the head coach. National League finalists Waterside Karori, lost coach Tori Schiltgen to the Wellington Phoenix and Wharfies bought in Martin Rodwell from Fencibles United in Auckland.

Waterside Karori lost a few players that had helped them to the National League final, and it showed in their first game when they went down 8-2 to Wellington United Diamonds. For Diamonds, Natalie Olson was on fire with five goals which gave a glimpse of what was to come for the Diamonds. That game also saw them win the Nora Watkins Challenge Shield.

That game set the tone for Diamonds season; they followed it up with two 6-0 wins (over Palmerston North United and Taradale). Their next game, probably the worst of their season saw them scramble a late winner against their new coaches' old team, Victoria University to sneak a 2-1 win. They went through the season unbeaten, scoring an outstanding 97 goals and conceding just six. Natalie Olson was on fire all season scoring 38 goals in totals (35 league & three in the Kate Sheppard Cup), scoring six hat-tricks, twice getting five and once equalling her personal best of six goals in a game. During this she managed her 100th goal for club as well as her 150th appearance and was selected to play international football for the country of her birth, Thailand. The excellent Hannah Pilley chipped in with 16 goals. The club's top ever women's goalscorer, Jemma Robertson (144 goals) got just one this season, but playing all year at right back probably didn't help. She did make the incredible milestone of becoming the first Diamonds female player to make 200 tier one appearances, a record only bettered by club legends Mike Simeonoff and Jeff Strom from the 1970's & 80s. Captain Zoe Barrott also achieved 100 appearances.

League runners up were the newcomers, **Wellington Phoenix U18s**, who despite using 41 players, lost just 3 games (Wellington United 1-2, 0-3, Waterside Karori 2-7) and drew 1 (Petone 0-0). Katie Pugh (13) and Bridie Christie (10) led the way in the goalscoring.

The battle for third place was between Waterside Karori and Petone and it was fierce, especially as the victor would qualify for the National League. **Petone** emerged victorious by one point. Ryan McGlinchley's small squad of just 22 nearly blew it with a continuing inability to beat a weaker Palmerston North Marist (drawing 0-0 & 1-1) and a 5-0 hammering from Wellington United on a Friday night at Newtown Park. But they overcame Waterside Karori 2-1 to grab the national league spot. Pepi Olliver-Bell top scored with 19 goals.

**Waterside Karori**, who had finished runners up to Auckland United in last year's National League Grand Final, retained just 10 players from the season before and it showed up especially in their first games (0-4 v Phoenix, 2-8 v Diamonds), but after this they went on a run of six wins, no doubt helped by the arrival of Football Fern, Amelia Abbott, from the Wellington Phoenix. Renee Bacon (21) and Nicola Ross (15) lead the way in the goalscoring stakes, but surprise dropped points to both Palmerston North teams (Marist 2-2, United 1-1) and a 1-2 home loss to Petone saw them finish in fourth place and miss out on National League.

11 points behind Waterside Karori, it was the battle of the best Central Region teams with Palmerston North Marist and Taradale battling it out. When the league was called the W-League **Palmerston North Marist** were the only central region team in the league and as a result were very competitive regularly finishing in the top three. With the addition of Taradale and Moturoa and then this season Palmerston North United they have been severely weakened. They won seven games, one less than Taradale, but four draws allowed Mikalea Bouwmeister's team to finish in fifth place.

**Taradale**, who had a small squad of just 24 players won eight games which was more than Palmerston North Marist, but they also lost eight games, but they comfortably finished in sixth place.

12 points behind, the bottom four of Miramar Rangers, Palmerston North United, Moturoa and Victoria University was effectively its own league with just four points separating the four teams.

All of these teams (except Victoria University, who were already there) struggled with the step up to Central League. **Miramar Rangers** managed three wins over Moturoa (twice) and Palmerston North United, but it was a 1-1 draw with Palmerston North Marist that was likely the highlight of their season and helped keep them in the league for 2026.

A young **Palmerston North United** (a merger between Massey University, Red Sox Manawatu & Palmerston North End) teams best results came against Capital teams, a double over Victoria University (1-0, 3-1), a win over Miramar (1-0) and a surprise 1-1 draw with Waterside Karori gave them 11 points, which was incidentally the same as the number of goals they scored!

Another young team was New Plymouth's **Moturoa** who used 34 players, they managed three wins (PNU 3-0, VUW 2-0, Taradale 1-0) and a draw (PNU 1-1), scored only 12 goals and conceded 50, including 10 times by three or more.

**Victoria University**, who had picked up former Waterside Karori coach, Bill Robertson started with a 1-0 win against Moturoa, but their only other was a 3-2 win over Taradale. Club stalwart, Nicole Baird, who in the past could have been described as a goal machine, top scored with just three. Eight times University conceded five or more goals and they finished the season with just eight points and will be playing in Capital Premier next season.

## Capital Premier

As with the Central League, Capital Football decided that the Capital Premier Division would also be increased to a 10 team league. Despite protests from clubs and warnings of some clubs being unable to compete, Capital Football pushed ahead with the increase to 10 teams. Unfortunately it took just one week for the warnings to come to fruition when Island Bay United, after losing 10-1 in their first game withdrew from the league. They were replaced by Western Suburbs, who despite beating Petone Reserves 3-2 in their first game went on to finish ninth, conceding 92 goals, three times over 10 in one game!

**Seatoun**, relegated from Central League, bounced back straight away. Coach Hugo Barber-Dale lead the team to only 1 loss (0-1 to University) as they went straight back up to Central League. Amy Foster with 14 and Nikola Szemtirmay-Ross with 10 led the goalscoring as Seaton scored 59.

**Wellington United Sapphires**, who had won the league in the previous three seasons, started slowly with just two wins in their first six games. Their last 12 games saw them suffer just a loss and a draw and they finished runners up just two points behind Seatoun. The club continued their policy of using this team to bring new players in and used 38 during the season. Ashleigh McCutcheon top scored with 22.

Third place went to **Te Kotahitanga**, who were supporting their new name gifted to them by local iwi, replacing the cumbersome Horowhenua Costal they had used the previous season. The majority of the team came from the Kapiti Coast United team and their coach was the everlasting Sean Kelly. They only lost two and drew one in the season, with Madison Beetham (18) and Vanessa Addy (10) top scoring.

**Upper Hutt City** used 22 players under coach Callum Martin and were the leagues top scoring team, netting 81 times, easily ahead of Wellington United who scored 60! Becky Stewart top scored with 20 goals which took her over 100 for the club Billie Cook (18), Emma Lavery (13), and Asha Dyson (10) helped out.

Eight points covered the next four teams. **Petone Reserves** finished in fifth place, three times managing to net six or more goals. Sixth place went to **Waterside Karori Reserves**, who Aimee Cherry scored 16 goals for, while **Victoria University Reserves** who used 35 players during the season finished the season in seventh place. **Wairarapa United** had lost just two games in their first seven but failed to win all but one after that finished in eighth place with 18 points.

**Western Suburbs**, who had stepped in at the last minute to take the hapless Island Bay United's place, started with a 3-2 win over Petone Reserves, but they only managed three more wins over the season and conceded 92 goals.

**North Wellington** had a small squad of 24 players and only managed one win all season, 3-0 over Victoria University Reserves. Draws against Waterside Karori Reserves and Western Suburbs weren't enough and with only five points they were relegated to Wellington Division One.

#### MATCH REPORT

Auckland United have won their second consecutive Delivereasy Kate Sheppard Cup crown with a 4-1 win over the Wellington Phoenix Women's Reserves in the 2025 final at North Harbour Stadium.

Two goals from Ava Collins led United to glory, whilst Chloe Knott received the Maia Jackman Trophy for the best player of the final.

Victory makes it three Delivereasy Kate Sheppard Cup titles in four seasons for United, having also won in 2024 and 2022.

Winners over Western Springs in the final last year, Auckland United were the aggressors again this time around and took an early lead.

Alexis Cook won a penalty in the 13th minute, and Zoe Benson tucked the resulting spot kick past the diving arms of Brooke Neary into the bottom-left corner of the net.

The Phoenix reserves rallied though, and were soon level when Amber De Wit split the Auckland defence with a pinpoint pass on the counter-attack, and Grace Bartlett poked the ball past Hannah Mitchell in the 24th minute.

United didn't let that phase them, and continued to dictate more of the possession and field territory.

Danielle Canham had a great chance to put them back ahead when Neary dropped a routine delivery into the box, only to have her effort blocked off the line.

Chloe Knott scored their second goal soon after, picking out the top left corner of the net with a stunning strike on her right foot from the top of the box.

The goals kept coming for United, and they added a third just before half-time, when the Phoenix defence failed to clear a ball into the box and Ava Collins was on hand to pounce.

Ford Football Ferns international Manaia Elliott tried to lift the Phoenix reserves in the second half, but the closest she came was a shot straight at Mitchell.

Instead Auckland United continued to tighten their grip, Knott causing problems down the left with a couple of shots on goal.

The fourth goal came in the 68th minute, when Collins converted a one-on-one opportunity with Neary, and scored her second.

Knott almost added her second moments later too, forcing Neary into a good save from a close-range header in front of goal.

Rene Wasi had an opportunity late off the bench, but saw her effort turned away as Auckland United held out for more Delivereasy Kate Sheppard Cup success.

## 2025 GRAND FINAL

### MATCH REPORT

Auckland United have further cemented their place in New Zealand football history, securing a third consecutive Dettol National League Championship Grand Final title with a 1–0 victory over city rivals Eastern Suburbs at Keith Hay Park in Tāmaki Makaurau, Auckland.

The two sides entered the final well acquainted, having already met four times in the 2025 season, most recently sharing a 1–1 draw in October. Both clubs boast some of the strongest squads in the league, featuring multiple Ford Football Ferns across their line-ups.

In a tight and tactical first half, the match unfolded largely as a midfield battle with clear-cut chances hard to come by. Eastern Suburbs enjoyed the better passages of possession but were unable to convert pressure into meaningful opportunities.

The breakthrough arrived in the 36th minute when captain Talisha Green delivered a long ball from deep that caught the Suburbs defence off guard. Zoe Benson reacted sharply, beating her marker to the pass and firing at goalkeeper Corina Brown. Brown parried the initial shot, but Benson was quickest to the rebound, guiding it home to give United a 1–0 lead.

The second half opened up as Eastern Suburbs chased an equaliser. Their best chances came late: Yukino Nishizono unleashed a powerful effort from 30 metres that sailed just over, before Ruby Nathan—formerly of Auckland United—beat her defender on the byline and picked out Sammi Tawharu, who lifted her close-range attempt over the bar.

Moments later the final whistle confirmed Auckland United as back-to-back-to-back champions, ensuring the Dettol National League Championship trophy remains at Keith Hay Park for another year.

**MATCH REPORT**

**Auckland United FC have retained their OFC Women's Champions League title with a hard fought 1-0 win over Hekari Womens FC in the final at Stade Pater in Papeete.**

The New Zealand champions scored the only goal of the game in the 26<sup>th</sup> minute through midfielder Danielle Canham and withstood plenty of pressure from the Papua New Guinea side in the second half but kept their composure in defence to secure the win.

For Hekari Womens FC it's a bitter pill to swallow, having lost the final last year in Honiara by the same score. Ericsson Komeng's side had suffered a major blow before kick-off with playmaker Ramona Padio ruled out for six weeks with an ankle injury suffered in the semi-final win over Ba Women FC.

Without Padio, Hekari were a distant second best in the opening half as Auckland United FC came out with real intent and dominated the midfield exchanges. They came close to taking the lead in the opening minute when Danielle Canham thundered a shot against the crossbar.

Striker Zoe Benson fired just wide of the left hand upright in the 15<sup>th</sup> minute after finding herself clear inside the box as the New Zealanders quickly found their rhythm.

Up front for Hekari Marie Kaipu found herself largely isolated on attack and unable to test Hannah Mitchell in the Auckland United goal. Auckland United FC deservedly took the lead in the 26<sup>th</sup> minute when a corner the ball was played out to Yume Harashima who drove the ball into the box. Chloe Knott back heeled the ball into Canham who got a touch, and the ball somehow squeezed past Gloria Læli in the Hekari Womens FC goal.

The Kiwis should have doubled their lead in the 42<sup>nd</sup> minute when Læli spilled the ball and Knott fired over the bar when she could have placed the ball into the back of the net.

Auckland United FC started the second half on the front foot with captain Talisha Green heading straight at Læli five minutes in. Auckland United FC's Saskia Vosper. Komeng made a couple of changes to his side, and it brought more urgency into Hekari's play as the match wore on. Their best chance to equalise came in the 64<sup>th</sup> minute when Kaipu threaded a ball through on goal to Nenny Elipas, but the advancing Mitchell made a strong save to deny the Hekari forward an equaliser.

Hekari continued to surge forward but the final pass often went astray, and promising positions ultimately led to nothing. Auckland United controlled the last 15 minutes and ran down the clock effectively to secure a deserved victory. Ben Bate's side will compete in the inaugural FIFA Women's Champions Cup next year in a playoff against the AFC champions with the winner of that match visiting the CAF champions in round two.

The New Zealanders are also well placed to be the Oceania representative at the inaugural FIFA Club World Cup to be played in 2028. AS Pirae was awarded the fair play award while Auckland United's Hannah Mitchell won the golden glove for goalkeeper of the tournament, Auckland United's Zoe Benson won the golden boot with eight goals and the golden ball for Player of the Tournament was awarded to Saskia Vosper from Auckland United FC.
